## Practice Overview

---

Alastair practices public, competition and commercial law. He has acted in a number of important and high-profile cases including:

- **London Metal Exchange** – \$470m damages claim arising out of the LME's cancellation of nickel futures trades (acting for the LME, led by Jonathan Crow KC).
- **Shvidler** – human rights challenge to Eugene Shvidler's sanctions designation (acting for Mr Shvidler, led by Lord Anderson KC).
- **Premier League** – acting for the Premier League in Man City's challenge to rules concerning associated party transactions (led by Marie Demetriou KC and Andrew Hunter KC).
- **Bulb** – subsidy control challenge to the sale of Bulb Energy Limited (acting for the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero, led by Jason Coppel KC).
